AGRO-MOS® *directions for use*

Apply AGRO-MOS at 14-28 oz/acre. Product performance is best if used within 24 months from date of manufacture.

AGRO-MOS can be applied with most regular fungicide and/or insecticide application programs. Compatibility testing should be done. Non-ionic Spreader Stickers: Only non-ionic spreader-stickers, which have been approved for use on growing and harvested crops, may be used.

Crop	oz/acre	Time of Application
Beans, field	14	At 4-leaf stage. Repeat every 2-3 weeks.
Blueberry	14	At leaf expansion. Repeat every 2 weeks.
Carrots, beets, root vegetables	14	Beginning at 40 DAE. Repeat every 2-3 weeks.
Cucumber, pumpkin, squash, zucchini	14	1 week after transplant. Repeat every 2 weeks.
Grapes, table	14	1 week after transplant. Repeat every 2-3 weeks.
Grapes, wine	14	6-8 applications every 2 weeks from sprouting (8" branches) until just before maturation.
Peas	14	1 week after transplant. Repeat every 2 weeks.
Pome fruit, Stone fruit	14	Every 2-3 weeks beginning at 2" shoot length.
Potatoes	14	1 week after transplant. Repeat every 2 weeks.
Strawberries & vine berries	14	1 week after transplant. Repeat every 2 weeks.
Sugar beets	14	3-4 weeks after planting. Repeat every 2-3 weeks.
Turfgrass	14	Every 2 weeks during growing season.
